

# BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FUNDING SOURCES

## 1. Behavioral Health-Managed Care Organizations (BHMCO)

### ELIGIBILITY

- Parents income
- Documented medical or behavioral health diagnosis
- Dependent of a county children and youth agency

### TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES COVERED (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO)

- Outpatient therapy
- Intensive Behavioral Health Services (IBHS) - medical necessity needed
- Family Based Mental Health Services (FBMH) - medical necessity needed
- Multi-systemic Therapy (MST) - medical necessity needed
- Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) - medical necessity needed
- Community Residential Rehabilitation (CRR) Host Home - medical necessity needed
- Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities (PRTF) - medical necessity needed

## 2. County Base Funding

### ELIGIBILITY

- Uninsured
- Underinsured

### TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES COVERED (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO)

- Outpatient therapy
- Psychiatric or Psychological evaluations
- Family Based Mental Health Services (FBMHS)
- Student Assistance Program (SAP)

## 3. Private Insurance

### ELIGIBILITY

- Based on Parents/Guardians employment
- Based on Parents/Guardians choice from the Marketplace

### TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES COVERED

- Depending on insurance plan—May or may not include behavioral health coverage.
- If behavioral health coverage is included, it is up to the plan which services are covered.
- Private insurances DO NOT cover Family Based Mental Health Services, Multi-systemic Therapy, Community Residential Rehabilitation Host Home as they are Third Party Liability exempt.

## 4. County Children & Youth, Juvenile Justice, Education

### ELIGIBILITY

- Being adjudicated dependent/delinquent
- When education system cannot educate in public school system

### TYPES OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES COVERED

- Behavioral Health Services not otherwise funded
