They are licensed as a Child Residential and Day Treatment Facility by the PA Dept. of Human Services and approved by the PA Dept of Education to provide instruction under the Alternative Education for Disruptive Youth Programs. Their Board of

Directors is composed of faithful, able brethren who are members in good standing in their home congregations and are committed to the teachings of Christ as defined by the 1632 Mennonite Confession of Faith.
