CFSR Round 4 is Coming to Pennsylvania!

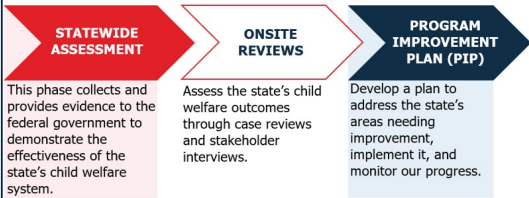
Child and Family Services Reviews (CFSRs) are a joint local, state, and federal effort designed to:
